What is TAP?

A program designed to encourage and support students in their goal of transferring to a four-year college or university. This comprehensive program includes

Counseling, English, Math, Reading and general education courses.



What are the benefits of TAP?

- Reserved sections of English, Reading, Math and Counseling.
- Additional personal and academic support from instructors, counselors, and peer facilitators.
- Opportunities to develop a peer support system.
- Classes in college success and career and life planning.
- TAP Counselors working closely with students to ensure a successful transfer.
- Encouragement to visit leading colleges and universities.

How do I participate in TAP?

- Eligible to enroll in the TAP section of Counseling 151.
- Eligible to enroll in English 59, 60, or 100 *and/or*
- Eligible to enroll in Math 15, 20, or 40 *and/or*
- Eligible to enroll in Reading 56 or 96.
- Available to attend classes Monday through Thursday from 7:00a.m. to 4:00p.m.
- Completed 15 or less units of general education courses.
- Commitment to additional time for Supplemental Instruction.
- Willingness to participate in TAP activities.
