Road Map to earning a Public Relations Certificate

Below is a suggested course study plan in order to earn a Public Relations Certificate.

Certificates represent proficiency in theory and practice in specific areas. They can be acquired as vocational training, in conjunction with the pursuit of an AA degree or while satisfying requirements for transferring to a four-year degree program.

Many of the required and elective courses overlap, and students frequently find they qualify for certificates in addition to degrees.
