STUDENT TRANSFER ACHIEVEMENT REFORM ACT (SB 1440)



- Signed into Legislation on September 29, 2010
- Opportunity to earn an associate degree and prepare for CSU transfer at the same time
- Guaranteed admission into the CSU system
 - There is **NO** guarantee students will get into their intended CSU campus

STUDENT TRANSFER ACHIEVEMENT REFORM ACT (SB 1440)



- This degree is defined by having sixty (60) transferrable units that include units in a major or area of emphasis using the IGETC or CSU General Education Breadth pattern.
- Guaranteed to need only need 60 units to fulfill graduation requirements once admitted to a CSU
- CSUs are prohibited from requiring students to repeat courses that are similar to those completed at the community college for the associate degree for transfer

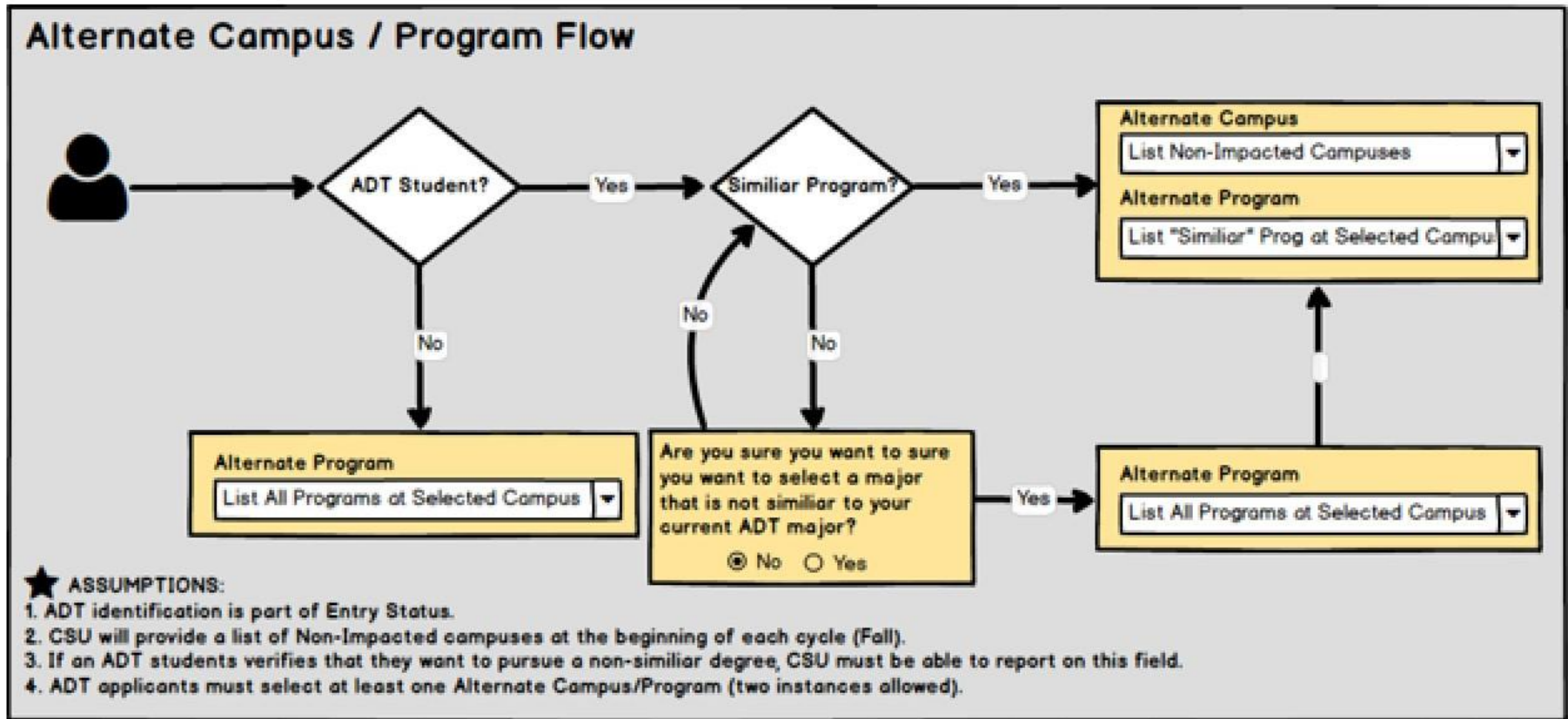

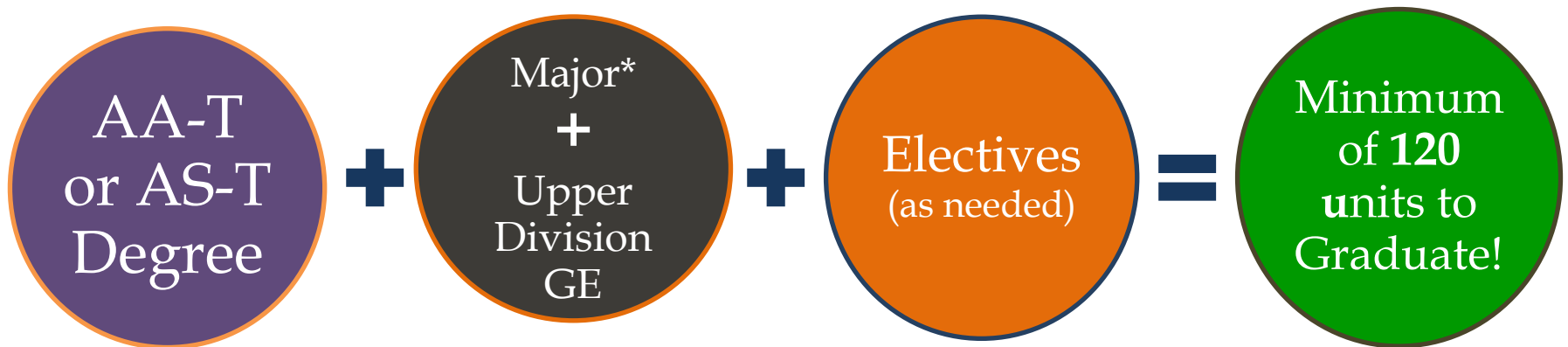

Things You Need To Keep In Mind...

- **Transfer Degree can be Cancelled**
 - If a student changes their academic plan by either changing their major, declaring a second major, declaring a minor, or declaring a second concentration/non approved concentration will cancel the transfer degree agreement.
- **What does this mean when a Transfer Degree Agreement is cancelled?**
 - If a transfer degree is cancelled, this means that the University can no longer guarantee that only 60 units are required to satisfy graduation requirements, post-transfer.
 - In regards to General Education, a student may be required to take additional GE courses to satisfy unmet requirements, as well as possibly fulfill additional major requirements.
- **IMPORTANT NOTE:** when a Transfer Degree Agreement is cancelled, it only alters remaining degree requirements. A student's admission is not rescinded. This is not the same, and a student's admissions should not be compromised.

Things You Need To Keep In Mind Cont...

- **Short Units to meet Graduation Requirement**
 - When a student is short units in meeting the minimum 120 units required to graduate and needs Elective units, it is common to recommend declaring a second major or a minor to fulfill remaining units. – **CANCELLED Transfer Degree**
- **General Education Requirement**
 - **AREA B:** Depending on major, GE Area B is a common requirement that tends to be short in meeting the minimum 12 units required even when the student has taken courses for the Transfer Degree that fulfill B.1, B.2, B.3, and B.4.
 - **D.3 (American History) or D.4 (American Government)** – students can transfer to a CSU without this area completed. It is expected that these course requirements will be completed at the intended institution.
- **CSU GE Certification/IGETC**
 - These types of certifications are not required but very helpful.
