Suggested 2-Year Sequence for the Studio Arts Associate in Arts Degree for Transfer (ADT)

Catalog Year: 2017-2018

This plan is a suggested 2-year sequence for full-time students who are college ready and planning to transfer to a California State University (CSU). It consists of general education and major coursework that must total at least 60 CSU transferrable units (courses 100-299). Students may take courses out of the sequence as long as they fulfill any applicable prerequisites/corequisites and may take courses offered during summer session. Official degree requirements are found in the Fullerton College Catalog.

All Fullerton College students need to meet with an academic counselor for a Student Education Program Plan (SEPP) to discuss personalized academic planning and transfer options. Requirements are subject to change and vary based on catalog year, assessment results, AP/IB credit, other college coursework, courses taken during the summer, etc. Students may also refer to Degree Works through Mygateway to confirm completion of specific requirements.
