Suggested 2-Year Sequence for the Illustration Certificate

Catalog Year: 2017-2018

This plan is a suggested 2-year sequence for full-time students who are college ready and planning to complete a Certificate in the Area of Illustration. The **Illustration Certificate** Program consists of 40-43 units. There are a total of 31-32 required units and a total of 9-11 restricted elective units. A minimum grade of "C" or better is required for each course taken.

Official degree requirements are found in the <u>Fullerton College Catalogue</u>. All Fullerton College students need to meet with an academic counselor for a personalized Student Education Program Plan (SEPP) and to discuss additional transfer options. Requirements are subject to change and may vary based on catalog year, assessment results, AP/IB credit, other college coursework, courses taken during the summer, etc.

The Illustration Certificate Program is designed to emphasize concepts, strategies and skill development in order to facilitate the student's portfolio presentation, which may be appropriate for a variety of careers in the Commercial Arts field, including editorial and advertising illustration, concept design and illustration for products, conceptual art for the game and entertainment industry, and illustration for the toy and theme park industries.
