Mark Yokoyama began his career in public service in 1987 when he became a Police Officer with the La Palma Police Department. Over the course of the next thirty years Yokoyama worked for California Police Departments in La Palma, Newark, Cypress and Alhambra working varied assignments, supervisory and command positions and serving the last eight years of his policing career as the Chief of Police in the City of Cypress and the City of Alhambra. In May 2016, Chief Yokoyama was appointed the City Manager for the City of Alhambra in Los Angeles County where he oversaw the day-to-day operations of ten City departments, including municipal Police and Fire Departments. In December 2017, Yokoyama accepted the position of Dean with the Department of Public Safety at Rio Hondo College. Yokoyama holds a Master's Degree from the University of Southern California and California State University Dominguez Hills, and a Bachelor's Degree from the University of La Verne. He is a graduate of the FBI National Academy, P.O.S.T. Command College, and the Senior Management Institute for Police. Professionally he is a member of the FBI National Academy Associates, the International Association of Chiefs of Police, and the California Police Chiefs Association.
