101A Financial Accounting ADVISORY – While there are no prerequisite courses for 101A Financial Accounting at Fullerton College, the following skills are necessary to be successful:

Basic Math – ability to calculate fractions, decimals, percentages, prorations, and unknown values in equations

Critical Thinking – ability to analyze, keep an open mind, solve problems, organize with clear goals, and keep deadlines

Communication – strong written & oral skills, ability to listen & ask the right questions

Microsoft's Office 365 – ability to install Office 365 supplied at no charge by Fullerton College

365 Office – PowerPoint presentation and basic Excel spreadsheet skills Time Commitment – may require up to 3 hours of homework per week, for each hour of class time. Homework will include accounting cycle and comprehensive problems, and group projects.
