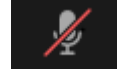

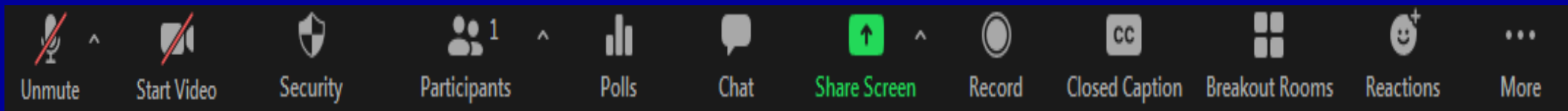

COSMETOLOGY

Cosmetic treatment of Hair, Skin, and Nails

- **Hair:** Hair cutting, permanent waving and chemical straightening, hair coloring and bleaching, and hairstyling
- **Skin:** Facials, temporary hair removal (tweezing & waxing), and makeup
- **Nails:** Manicures, pedicures, and artificial nails (tips, wraps, & acrylic)
- **All include:** Health and safety, disinfection and sanitation, anatomy and physiology, chemistry, electricity, professional image, salon business, and people skills

Cosmetologist – person licensed to provide cosmetic treatments



JOB OUTLOOK *and* **EARNING**

Employment is projected to grow 8% from 2018 to 2028

- Faster than the average for all occupations at 5%
- Overall job opportunities are expected to be good
- Job openings will stem from the need to replace workers who transfer to other occupations, retire, or leave the occupation
- Expect strong competition for jobs and clients at higher paying salons

California annual wages \$23,620 to \$46,980

- Does not reflect all income for cosmetologists, actual earnings may not be reported for self-employed cosmetologists
- 44% self-employed cosmetologists
- High quality work and customer service usually contribute to greater tip totals

U.S. BUREAU OF LABOR STATISTICS

IMPORTANT QUALITIES *For Success*

Creativity. Must keep up with the latest trends and be ready to try new hairstyles for clients.

Customer-service skills. Must be pleasant, friendly, and able to interact with customers in order to retain clients.

Listening skills. Be a good listener, listen carefully to what the clients want in order to make sure that the client is happy with the result.

Physical stamina. Must be able to stand on your feet for long periods of time.

Tidiness. Must keep a neat personal appearance and keep work area clean and sanitary so clients feel safe and comfortable enough so that they want to return.

Time-management skills. Need to manage time efficiently when scheduling appointments and providing services, clients who receive timely hair care are more likely to return.

U.S. BUREAU OF LABOR STATISTICS

Research shows that opportunity to succeed will come from:

- 15% Technical Skills learned
- 85% People and Communication Skills developed



California Licensure Requirements

All states require Cosmetologists to be licensed

- 1. Graduate from a state approved cosmetology program**
 - Fullerton College 1600 Cosmetology Program is approved
 - 1600 clocked hours of Technical Instruction and Practical Instruction
 - Fullerton College Cosmetology Program consists of five consecutive courses to complete
 - Each course requires a “C” grade or higher to pass to the next course
- 2. Pass a state written examination**
 - You must apply for the examination
 - Age 17 years or older
 - Completion of 10th grade or equivalency
 - Social Security Number or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number
 - Valid and current pictured identification (driver’s license, passport, military)
 - Proof of Training
 - Pay an examination and initial license fee of \$125.00 (fees are subject to change)
 - You may be denied if you have been convicted of a crime or matters outlined in the Business and Professions (B&P) Code Section 480

- 3. Fullerton College pass rate for July 1, 2021 through September 30, 2021**
 - Written 86% (51 out of 59)
 - Practical 95% (52 out of 55)

Senate Bill (SB) 803

SB 803 becomes effective January 1, 2022

Two major changes:

1. Reduces the cosmetology and barbering programs to 1,000 hours (from 1,600 and 1,500 respectively).
2. Removes the practical examination and therefore eliminates the pre-application process.

NOTIFICATION:

Students must complete an approved program and receive a *proof of training* in order to submit for testing by the State Board.

Fullerton College will continue the 1,600 hour program until a new program is approved, that may take significant time.

Current students will still need to complete the 1,600 hour program and earn a *proof of training*.

Curriculum

The Cosmetology Program is designed to engage the learner in meaningful learning

There are **two important educational foundations** that we strive to achieve in our curriculum:

- 1. Prepare students for the state licensure examination**
- 2. Train students with professional entry level skills and knowledge for careers in the salon industry**

Level 2	321-640	Beginner & Intermediate Level *Mannequin head practices (real & simulated products) *Mannequin hand & foot practices (real product) *Mannequin Hair Show (hairstyle, makeup, & nails)
Level 3	641-960	Intermediate & Beginner Salon Level *Mannequin practices (real & simulated products) *Mannequin hand & foot practices (real product) *Mannequin Hair Show (updo hairstyle, makeup & nails)
Level 4	961-1280	Advanced & Intermediate Salon Level *Mannequin head practices (real & simulated products) *Mannequin hand & foot practices (real product) *Mannequin Hair Show (haircut, haircolor, hairstyle, & makeup)
Level 5	1281-1600	State Board & Advanced Salon Level *State Board written practices for licensure examination *Mannequin head practices (real & simulated products) *Mannequin hand & foot practices (real product) *Mannequin Hair Show (Bridal hairstyle, makeup, & nails)

1600 hours of Technical & Practical Instruction are tracked on an electronic timecard daily

SPRING 2022 SESSION:

- Day Class – 1st 8-week session 1/24/22 – 3/18/22 (CRN 20988)
- Day Class – 2nd 8-week session 3/28/22 – 5/18/22 (CRN 21034)
- Evening Class – 16-week session 1/24/21 – 5/19/22 (CRN 20655)
- Spring Recess – 3/21/22 – 3/25/22

Day Students (Full-Time)

- Monday through Friday
- 7:00 AM to 4:30 PM (breaks & 30-minute lunch)
- 9 hours daily / 45 hours weekly
- 8 weeks to complete each course
- 1 year to complete the 1600 hour program
- Spring, Summer, and Fall

Evening Students (Part-Time)

- Monday through Thursday
- 5:00 PM to 10:30 PM (breaks)
- 5 ½ hours daily / 22 hours weekly
- 16 weeks to complete each course
- 2 ½ years to complete the 1600 hour program
- Spring and Fall (Summer not offered)

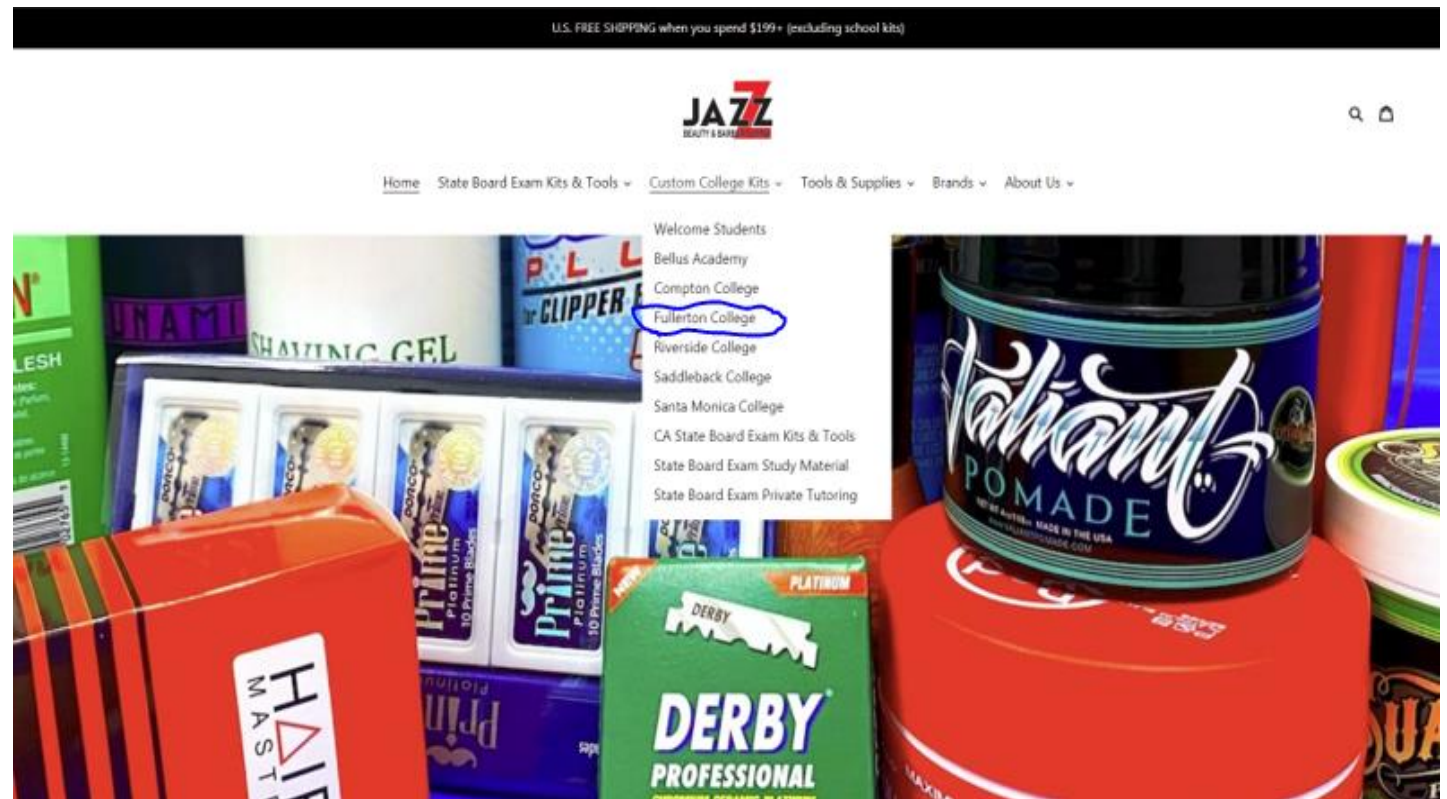
