Getting started:

1. To enroll, visit Fullerton College website and apply to the college for a student ID

2. Check Fullerton College class schedule for current add/drop dates
 - Recommended courses for 1st Semester:
 1. COSM 060 F (3-units)
 2. COSM 060LF (3-units)
3. 1st Day of class – Provide a copy of your current valid CA Cosmetology (or Esthetician/Barber) license & verify the required minimum three years of salon/spa experience.

NOTE: COSM 060 F and COSM 062 F includes the opportunity for students to complete 600 required clock hours of laboratory observation as a student-instructor. Students will need to enroll in COSM 060LF, COSM 061LF, and COSM 062LF to complete the 600 clock hours and units required. Pivot Point Member School.

1. **COSM 060F & COSM 062F: Two consecutive semesters.**

2. **COSM 060LF, COSM 061LF, COSM 062LF: Three consecutive semesters.**

COSM 061LF: Tuesday 7am – 12pm (Zoom) + 3-Hours of HYBRID laboratory assignments
COSM 062LF: Tuesday 7am – 4:30pm (Zoom) + 3-Hours of HYBRID laboratory assignments

600-Hour Program Course Description

COSM 060 F (3 Units): Instructional Techniques in Cosmetology/Barbering/Esthetician

Advisory: Concurrent enrollment in COSM 060LF.

This course is designed for licensed Cosmetologist/Barber/Esthetician who intend to teach in the post-secondary or private sector Cosmetology/Barbering/Esthetician schools. Pivot Point Member School. Pivot Point instructional aids, instructor kit and books, with an approximate cost of \$500 are required.

Scheduled Lecture: Monday 10:15am - 4pm (Zoom) (Fall/Spring 16-week semesters only)

COSM 060LF (3 Units): Instructional Techniques in Cosmetology/Barbering/Esthetician Laboratory

Advisory: Concurrent enrollment in COSM 060 F.

This course is designed to provide licensed cosmetologist/barber/esthetician with the opportunity to complete 600 required clock hours of laboratory observation as a student-instructor. Pivot Point Member School.

*Scheduled Laboratory: Tuesday 7am – 4:30pm (Zoom) + 3-Hours of HYBRID laboratory assignments
(Fall/Spring 16-week semesters only)*

COSM 061LF (2 Units): Intermediate Instructional Techniques in Cosmetology/Barbering/Esthetician Laboratory

Prerequisite: COSM 060LF with a grade of C or better

Advisory: Concurrent enrollment in COSM 062 F.

This intermediate course is designed to provide licensed cosmetologist/barber/esthetician with the opportunity to complete 600 required clock hours of laboratory observation as a student-instructor. Pivot Point Member School.

*Scheduled Laboratory: Tuesday 7am – 12pm (Zoom) + 3-Hours of HYBRID laboratory assignments
(Fall/Spring 16-week semesters & check Summer Schedule for availability and meeting times)*

COSM 062 F (3 Units): Advanced Instructional Techniques in Cosmetology/Barbering/Esthetician

Prerequisite: COSM 060 F with a grade of C or better

Advisory: Concurrent enrollment in COSM 061LF and/or COSM 062LF.

This course is designed to teach licensed Cosmetologist/Barber/Esthetician advanced instructional techniques. Pivot Point Member School.

Scheduled Lecture: Monday 10:15am - 4pm (Zoom) (Fall/Spring 16-week semesters only)

COSM 062LF (3 Units): Advanced Instructional Techniques in Cosmetology/Barbering/Esthetician Laboratory

Prerequisite: COSM 060LF with a grade of C or better

Advisory: Concurrent enrollment in COSM 062 F.

This advanced course is designed to provide licensed cosmetologist/barber/esthetician with the opportunity to complete 600 required clock hours of laboratory observation as a student-instructor. Pivot Point Member School.
