

Qualifications

- 1. High School Diploma (or equivalent)
- 2. CA Residency (or AB540 recipient)
- 3. First-time college student status

Extended Opportunity Program & Services

Eligibility:

EOP

1.Be a California Resident or AB540.

- 2.Be enrolled as a full-time college student (12 units)**
- 3. Have completed less than 40 degree-applicable units.
- 4. Qualify for the CA Community College Promise Grant (CCPG formerly the BOGG Free Wavier).
- 5. Must meet at least 1 of these Educational Qualifiers:
 - No high school diploma, GED or equivalent.
 - High School graduates with a GPA 2.5 or below.
 - First-generation college student.
 - Underrepresented student population.
 - Current or Former Foster Youth.
 - **Disability Support Services inquire about unit
 - recommendations.
