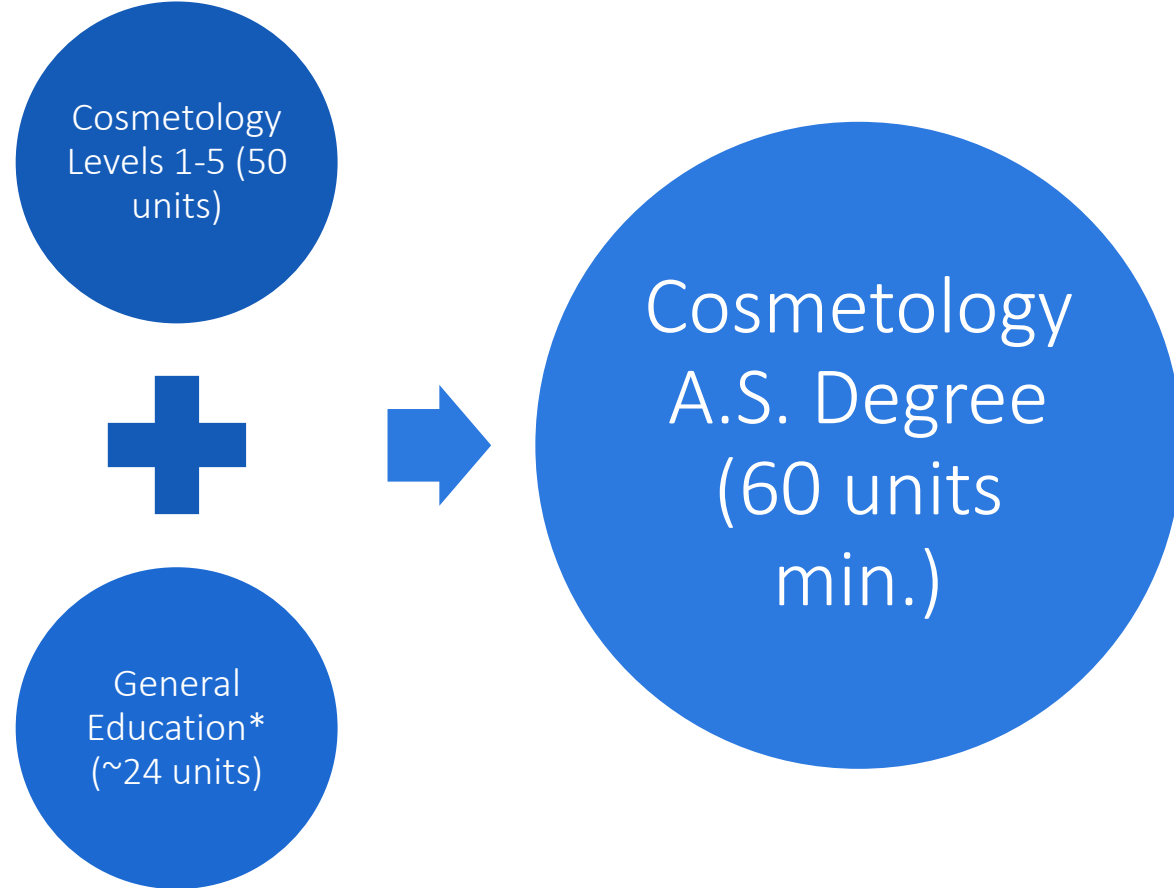

3. First-time college student status

EOPS Extended Opportunity
Program & Services

Eligibility:

1. Be a California Resident or AB540.
2. Be enrolled as a full-time college student (12 units)**
3. Have completed less than 40 degree-applicable units.
4. Qualify for the CA Community College Promise Grant (CCPG formerly the BOGG Free Wavier).
5. Must meet at least 1 of these Educational

Qualifiers:

- No high school diploma, GED or equivalent.
- High School graduates with a GPA 2.5 or below.
- First-generation college student.
- Underrepresented student population.
- Current or Former Foster Youth.
- **Disability Support Services inquire about unit recommendations.

Services:

- Priority Registration.
- Book Service Award.
- One-on-One Academic Counseling.
- EOPS Book Lending Program.
- Resourceful Student Services Specialist.
- EOPS Financial Aid Specialist.
- Assistance with the transfer process.
- Tutoring services.
